Children's Worship. Is on Vacation in July & August. We'll be back Sunday September 13.

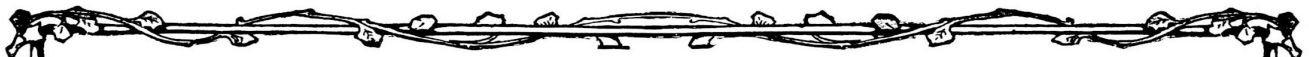
T-shirts are ready for pick-up! See Malinda in the Lounge during Coffee Hour.
