Young Adults Group continues on Sundays at 9:30am in the North Wing upstairs Lounge.

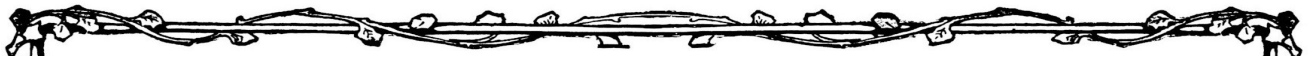
Justice & Advocacy Team meets today, June 21 at 12:15pm. **Education Team** meets next Sunday, June 28 at 12:15pm.
