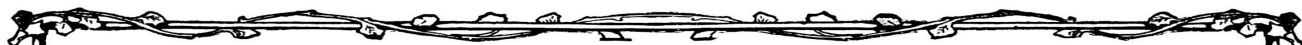
Grief Group and Walk In Love: Episcopal Beliefs & Practices meets next Sunday, May 17 at 9am
