Worship Team meets next Sunday, May 24 at 12:15pm

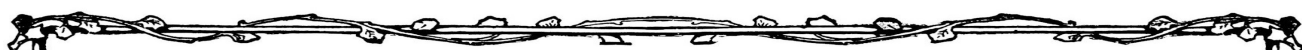
Curmudgeon's Lunch is Wednesday, May 20 noon at Arianna's on N. Sheppard.
