The Office is closed Tuesday, May 26.

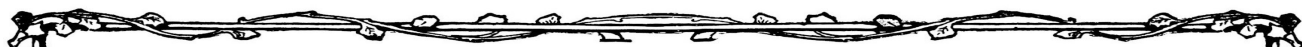
